Present: Cory Ross, District Manager; Linda Corse, and Katie Morrison, board supervisors; Heather Blunk and Emma Gregg, Ag Resource Specialist; Abby Reed, Conservation Assistant.

NRCS Updates:

- Local fund pool outreach can be started, just don't include dollar amounts yet.
- Programmatic updates: Sept 16 is the last day for regional conservation program..
- Last day of eligibility for FSA - Dec. (?).
- Start of October is the date if producers want to receive conservation stewardship payments.
- There are several trainings coming up.

VACD Updates:

- Annual meeting coming up November 17 - Lake Morey. It's a one day event and will include trainings.
- Cory and Linda attended the council meeting last Friday.
- Budget was approved for \$912K. Same as funding for last year, they will ask that this is the new base. There is talk about trying to work on a plan to find funding that is consistent, without having to ask each year (like license plate program, etc). Action Circles is facilitating a Hopes, Fears and Dreams discussion to collect ideas and plans for finding consistent funding.
- Personnel agreements were discussed: a contract between VACD and council for Claire's position and trying to formalize that.
- There was a presentation for an environmental justice discussion with Jennifer Burn from White River District.
- Act 250/ Act 181 appropriations agenda item turned into a 45 minute discussion. Discussion was about VACD and VCRD developing an outreach plan for these acts; end result was consensus that council needs to review this plan before it's submitted to the legislature.
- Cory and Linda were in Delaware for Northeast regional meeting. Spent most of the time in a management training session.

- Linda is looking to move on from being a council rep, would like to talk in January about someone else stepping into that role.

Personnel Committee Update:

- Worked through list of current personnel policies that are out of line with how we're currently operating. Developing a list of suggested policies, which they'll bring back to the board
- They are developing a position description for Cory's position. Issues with the current policy are related to the date when raises happen and when leave balances accrue. Would like to get everyone on the same calendar.
