5. New Office Space Update

- a. Land trust is exploring changing office, district has been invited to join
- b. Visited a house downtown with a large office space, space could work and is nice, but does not have enough parking. Owner of building is very open to leasing more parking spots nearby, very excited to work with us
- c. Another district has acquired funds to purchase a space, a legislator really wants to help other districts get office spaces in the next couple of years
- d. Will need to be furnished, set up with wifi
- e. Cory put together a staff survey, majority of staff are okay with forgoing raises in the next fiscal year

Tacking on best practices to existing Invasive Species Removal. Kelly from ottaquechee to include southern portion. There aren't that many places up there we would need to cover anyway. Different, but achieving the same goals. Requesting \$900,000, always run out of money every year.
